Chairman's Report: JV Springman/Paulette Greenberg

If you have the radio all day, think about getting a battery change. Come to Mobile Com to swap out a battery. In using the radios, say who you are calling first. Wait for a response. Mention an emergency right away if that is why you are calling. When reporting, keep it simple. If you find a missing parent, escort them to Mobile Com. If you find a lost child, Mobile Com will send an officer to you. Don't release a lost child until an officer arrives. If you have a medical emergency, state what the medical problem is
